Hundreds of people attended the World War One and Voluntary Aid Detachment (VAD) exhibition put on by Biddenden Local History Society in May 2015.

A makeshift hospital was set up and children were given the chance to experience what life was like for nurses and wounded soldiers. The village hall had actually been a VAD hospital from 1914-16 when 108 patients passed through. A replica of the war memorial was displayed, made by Richard Churton.
